LATE BUS INFORMATION

- Late Bus service is available for Stamford residents on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday afternoons. Buses depart at 4:45pm promptly.
- Your child can take the late bus to either the JCC or their REGULAR AFTERNOON bus stop.
- BCHA is only provided with 2 late buses. Your child will <u>not</u> be on their regular afternoon bus number. Ms. Danner will tell you which bus number your child will be taking in a confirmation email once registration closes.
- It will take about 2 weeks from the start of each session to iron out arrival time of buses bus routes depend on how many stops they have each afternoon.
- We strongly recommend that PreK and K students are picked up at the conclusion of their after school classes instead of sending them on the late bus.
